### ONE WAY IN...AND OUT

For the past month a suggested change in car parking for our weekend Masses appeared in our weekly bulletins.

Parishioners were invited to discuss the suggestion and then communicate their wisdom to Fr Noel.

Only one parishioner did who asked that the 6pm Mass be included in the proposed change.

The suggestion came from the Working Bee Group who raised the issue as a health and safety concern.

There not having been any objections the following will apply as from 20-21 August.

For the 6pm and 10.30am Masses cars enter the large car park in the usual way. Ten minutes before Mass finishes the car park signs will be changed so that the present entry gate becomes also the exit gate. Cars will not be permitted to exit via what is now the exit gate. It will be exclusively for pedestrians.

Parishioners who park in front of the Memorial Stations of the Cross wall are requested to back in thereby making exiting easier and safer.

Please note there is a 10km speed limit operating at all times.

**Peter**

*Peter has been called a stumbling saint.  
He is a great consolation to us because  
courage fails us all.  
All of us are mere mortals,  
who are inconstant in our beliefs.  
We must learn to forgive ourselves  
momentary weaknesses and failures.  
We need to surmount these things  
and see the world in less rigid terms.  
We must not judge ourselves or others  
by momentary inconsistencies,  
but rather by commitment given over a long time.  
Jesus was well aware of Peter's faults,  
but he saw that, in spite of everything,  
his heart was sound.  
Which meant he had the ability to love.  
And in the long run love is what counts.*
