Reading 1

Ex 22:20-26

Thus says the LORD:

"You shall not molest or oppress an alien, for you were once aliens yourselves in the land of Egypt. You shall not wrong any widow or orphan. If ever you wrong them and they cry out to me, I will surely hear their cry. My wrath will flare up, and I will kill you with the sword; then your own wives will be widows, and your children orphans.

"If you lend money to one of your poor neighbors among my people, you shall not act like an extortioner toward him by demanding interest from him.

If you take your neighbor's cloak as a pledge, you shall return it to him before sunset; for this cloak of his is the only covering he has for his body. What else has he to sleep in? If he cries out to me, I will hear him; for I am compassionate."

Reading 2

1 Thes 1:5C-10

Brothers and sisters:

You know what sort of people we were among you for your sake.

so that you became a model for all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.

For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth not only in Macedonia and in Achaia,

but in every place your faith in God has gone forth, so that we have no need to say anything.

For they themselves openly declare about us what sort of reception we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols

to serve the living and true God and to await his Son from heaven,

whom he raised from the dead,

Jesus, who delivers us from the coming wrath.

Gospel

Mt 22:34-40

When the Pharisees heard that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together, and one of them, a scholar of the law tested him by asking, "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?"

He said to him,

"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.

This is the greatest and the first commandment.

The second is like it:

You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments."



Reflection

The Total Gospel

To separate the two great commandments is a tragedy and goes clean contrary to the Gospel.

Yet unfortunately this often happens.

Those who have faith often have no love, and those who have love often have no faith.

Thus the Gospel has been torn in two.

Jesus spoke of two great commandments.

The first – that we should love God.

The second – that we should love our neighbour.

He didn't say that they were the same thing, but that they are like two sides of the one coin.

If we want the total Gospel we must have both.

He himself showed us how to do this.
